- **Regional Secretary**

Support the Regional Director at meetings; take minutes and distribute as agreed.

- **Young Members Coordinator**

Represent the needs and concerns of young members (those aged 18-30) in the region to ensure that the Campaign continues to attract the next generation of beer lovers and pub-goers. You'll also be part of the Young Members' Working Group who meet annually and conduct other business online.

- **Pubs Protection Officer**

Coordinate the efforts of pub protection campaigners in the region and share information at regional level.

- **Public Affairs Officer**

Liaise with branches' Public Affairs Officers in the region to elicit support from councillors, MPs and MEPs for CAMRA's campaigns.

- **Finance Officer**

Support and assist the Regional Director in carrying out their financial responsibilities and be the main point of contact for Branches and Beer Festival treasurers. Full role description and training is available for this role.

- **PubCo Liaison Officer**

Work with Branch Pub Company Liaison Officers (PCLOs) across the region in their liaison work with pub companies and pubs to gain information about their operations.

- **Heritage Pubs Coordinator**

To coordinate and encourage the work of Branches and members in the region/area on campaigning activity concerning heritage pubs.
