Support given by CAMRA's Volunteer Support Manager – along with templates etc to help you in this role. Would suit someone with experience of managing/supervising others, setting rotas etc. Attendance at the *monthly committee meetings would be expected.
- **Health & Safety Officer** – if you have H&S qualifications and experience of doing the H&S at events (e.g. a beer festival) then we'd love to hear from you. Assistance will be provided by CAMRA's Health & Safety Adviser. Ideal person would be local to Eastbourne as site visits and a presence at key times over the weekend would be required. Attendance at the occasional *monthly committee meetings would be appreciated.
