Notes: This is a list of producers of fruit and flavoured ciders that meet the criteria of our new definition, with an associated 'live' map. This new map and list are in addition to the existing map and list of producers of real cider and perry (which does not apply to fruit and flavoured ciders). Both maps and lists will be regularly updated and where possible will be published quarterly: <https://camra.org.uk/beer-and-cider/cider/promoting-real-cider-and-perry/>. Producers will be added to (and sometimes deleted from) the lists based on producers contacting us and providing the required information, information provided in the public domain and information from our Regional Cider Coordinators. **Please send additions and amendments to either of these two lists to cider@camra.org.uk**

Fruit and Flavoured Ciders are described in our cider styles guidance. To meet our new definition, they should have a real cider or perry base and be made with the addition post fermentation of pure juices or flavourings, never from concentrates, extracts or essences. Some producers only produce **elderflower** or **hopped ciders**, and these are listed separately.

Co-Ferments and Fermented Blends are listed together. In co-ferments the additional fruits or flavours are added pre-fermentation and fermented with the cider or perry. In fermented blends the additional fruits etc. are fermented, into for instance a fruit wine, and then blended with the cider or perry.

4% plus: We recognise that the majority of fruit ciders will have been diluted back to 4% ABV specifically for duty purposes. We recommend that where possible 'real cider and perry fruit and flavoured drinks' at a higher alcohol level should be encouraged and also provided.

Icons: In the map of fruit and flavoured cider producers each category is identified by an appropriate icon: 'strawberry' for fruit and flavoured; 'elderflower' and 'hop flower' as appropriate; 'bottle' for co-ferments and blends; and a 'plus icon' for those produced with an alcohol level higher than 4%.
